SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I the said Eva Coffey Williams

in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to Citizens Lumber Company

in the full and just sum of Seventy-Five Hundred and No/100(\$7500.00) Dollars, to be paid on November 29th, 1948

, with interest thereon from August 29, 1948 at the rate of Six (6%) per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10%) per cent. of the amount due thereon, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said Mortgagee, and its successors, heirs and Assigns forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State aforesaid, on the North side of East Tallulah Drive, in the City of Greenville, being a portion of lot # 117, shown on a plat of the property of T. P. Smith made by Dalton & Neves in May 1925, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the North side of East Tallulah Drive, 300 feet East from Smith Street at corner of lot #116, and running thence with line of said lot, N. 25-20 W. 242.8 feet to a stake in line of Blassingame property; thence with line of said property, N. 65-26 E. 70 feet to a stake; thence S. 25-20 E. 241.8 feet to a stake on East Tallulah Drive; thence with the Northern side of East Tallulah Drive, S. 64-40 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim same or any part thereof.
