porated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Thirteen-hundred and no/100
Dollars (\$1,300.00), with interest from date at the rate of
four per centum (4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable
at the office of The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina
in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may
designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Seven and 88/100
Dollars (\$7.88), commencing on the first day of

whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does
grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described
property situated in the county of Greenville, Gantt Township
State of South Carolina; known and designated as Lot No. 65 according to plat
of property of Woodfields, Inc., a subdivision located on the southwest
side of the Augusta Road, said lot having the following metes and bounds
as shown on plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, March, 1947, recorded
