NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dellara (83.00) to the Mortgager in land well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, State of South Carolina, situated on Elford Street, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on Elferd Street 1052 fast from the intersection of Elford Street and Thompson Street and running thence with Elferd Street N. 47 E. 412 feet to a stake; thence S. 10 E. 92 feet to a stake; thence S. 76 W. 322 feet to a stake; thence N. 12 W. 722 feet to the beginning corner as shown on a plat prepared by W. A. Adams, May 20th, 1913; being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by Margaret Scott by deed to be recorded."
