SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Constantine Sarides  
hereinafter called the mortgagor(s)  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly  
indebted to Elizabeth I. Herndon, as Executrix under the will of John N.  
Herndon, deceased  
hereinafter called the mortgagee(s), in the full and just sum of TWELVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED &  
no/100 - - - - - DOLLARS (\$12,500.00), to be paid  
Three years after date

, with interest thereon from date  
at the rate of Six (6%) percentum per annum, to be computed and paid  
quarterly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole  
amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose  
this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if, before  
its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should  
place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortga-  
gor(s) promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mort-  
gage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid,  
and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee(s) according to the terms of the said note, and also in con-  
sideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said mortgagor(s), in hand well and truly paid by the said mort-  
gagee(s) at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and  
released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Elizabeth I. Herndon as  
Executrix under the will of John N. Herndon, deceased, her heirs and  
assigns, forever:

All and singular that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land  
situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid,  
in the City of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds,  
to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Augusta Street at the intersection  
of Lots No. 3 and No. 4 and running thence with Augusta Street S. 40 1/2  
W. 50 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 5 and No. 6 on said  
street; thence S. 47-3/4 E. 100 feet to an iron pin corner of rock  
foundation; thence in a Northerly direction with said rock foundation  
50 feet to corner No. 3; thence with line of Lot No. 3, 100 feet to an  
iron pin 12 feet from the curbing on Augusta Street to the beginning  
corner. Being known as Lot 19, Block 1, page 89 of the City Block Book.

This is the same property conveyed to me by deed of Thrace M.  
Baker, et al, said deed dated June 10, 1946 and recorded in Deed Book  
294 at page 314.

certain 12 inch brick wall located along the Northeast edge of the  
above described lot and the right to tie on to and use the same as a  
party wall and all other rights therein which were conveyed to me by  
C. Kirby Hammond under Agreement dated August 4, 1948, recorded in the
