Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being at the Northeast corner of the intersection of East Fairview Avenue and Bennett Street in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having according to a survey made by A. C. Crouch, Engineer, August 2, 1948, the following metes and bounds. to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeast corner of the intersection of East Fairview Avenue and Bennett Street and running thence with the North side of East Fairview Avenue, S. 66-05 E. 145 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 30-05 E. 300 feet to an iron pin in the center of creek; thence up said creek following the meanderings thereof (the traverse line being N. 63-41 W. 144.4 feet) to point in the center of creek on the East side of Bennett Street; thence along the East edge of Bennett Street, S. 30-05 W. 308.6 feet to the beginning corner.
