in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, South Carolina, their successors and assigns,

all that tract or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 8.66 acres, and known and designated on plat of property of Mildred Hill, as Lots Nos. 2 and 4, situate about 9 miles from the City of Greenville on the Little Texas Road, and having, according to said plat, the following courses and distances:
