"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the East side of Fourth Avenue in Judson Mills No. 1 Village in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 15 as shown on a plat of Section 1 of Judson Mills Village made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in August, 1939, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at pages 11 and 12, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
