(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Twenty-Five Hundred and No/100- - - - DOLLARS (\$2500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%)- - - per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, about seven miles West of Greenville on the Old Buncombe Road, joined by lands now or formerly of Jenkins on the West, Allen C. Batson on the Northeast, Drummond on the Southeast and Old Buncombe Road on the East, containing acre, more or less, according to a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, August 1948, and being more particularly described according to said plat as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the Old Buncombe Road, corner of Jenkins lands and running thence N. 43-46 E. 191.8 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 30-45 E. 155.4 feet to an iron pin, corner of Drummond land; thence with Drummond land, S. 62-00 W. 155.7 feet to an iron pin in the Old Buncombe Road; thence N. 47-36 W. 101.1 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by Allen C. Batson by deed dated 31st of August, 1948, recorded in Volume 357 at Page 393."
