Whereas, SHERWOOD COURT APARTMENTS, INC. SENDS GREETING:

on demand

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of five (5%) percentum per annum, to be computed and paid

monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if, before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor(s) promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee(s) according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to it the said mortgagor(s), in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee(s) at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, S. C., its Successors and Assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the North side of Ridgeland Avenue, in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot #6 on plat of property of Sherwood Court Apartments, Inc. made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Ridgeland Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 5 and 6, said pin being 258.2 feet East from the Northeast corner of the intersection of Ridgeland Avenue and Allen Street, and running thence along the line of Lot 5 N. 2-16 W. 145 feet to iron pin; thence N. 87-44 E. 50 feet to iron pin; thence S. 2-16 E. 145 feet to iron pin on the North side of Ridgeland Avenue; thence along the North side of Ridgeland Avenue S. 87-44 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with the right of ingress and egress over a strip of land and a 15-foot alley along the rear of the above described property, and extending to Allen Street.
