full and just sum of SEVEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$ 7,000.00)
Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "J" at pages 102 and 103, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
"BEGINHING at a point on Boxwood Road at joint front corner of Lots Mos. 4 and 5, and running thence S. 19-30 W. 200 feet to a point, joint corners of Lots Nos. 4 and 5 and on the line of Lot No. 3; thence with the line of Lot No. 3, N. 89-49 E. 122.2 feet to an iron pin on line of Lot No. 4 and at the edge of Chick Springs Road; thence along Chick Springs Road, N. 3-45 E. 166 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Boxwood Road and Chick Springs Road; thence with Boxwood Road, N. 71-32 E. 70 feet to the point of beginning.
