forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Town-  
ship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on  
the East side of the Old Paris Mountain Road, being known and de-  
signated as a part of Lot 5 and a small part of Lot 4 of the property  
of Hartsell & Townes, as shown on a plat thereof by W. M. Rast, dated  
February 1930, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County, S. C. in Plat Book "G", Page 264, and having the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the East side of Old Paris Mountain  
Road at the corner of a 15-foot alley and running thence with said
