WHEREAS:

Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, is indebted to

C. Douglas Wilson & Co.

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Ten Thousand and no/100

Dollars (\$ 10,000.00), with interest from date at the rate of four per centum (4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co.

in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Fifty-two and 79/100

Dollars (\$ 52.79), commencing on the first day of July, 1949, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of June, 1974.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville, Gantt Township State of South Carolina; known and designated as Lot No. 101, according to plat

of property of Woodfields, a subdivision located on the southwest side of the Augusta Road, said lot having the following metes and bounds, according to plat by G. C. Jones, dated October, 1947 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, page 113:

Beginning at an iron pin on the eastern side of Milford Lane at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 101 and 104 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 104 S. 52-50 E. 137.3 feet to an iron pin on an unnamed street; thence along said unnamed street S. 50-00 W. 30.2 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said unnamed street S. 46-58 W. 59.5 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of said unnamed street and Old Farm Lane; thence along a curved line, the chord of which is S. 88-32 W. 14.2 feet to an iron pin on Old Farm Lane; thence along Old Farm Lane N. 50-38 W. 80.9 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Old Farm Lane and Milford Lane; thence along a curved line, the chord of which is N. 8-48 W. 38.2 feet to an iron pin on Milford Lane; thence along Milford Lane N. 38-36 E. 72 feet to the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the improvements thereon and the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining; all the rents, issues, and profits thereof (provided, however, that the Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and retain the said rents, issues, and profits until default hereunder); all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the premises herein described and in addition thereto the following described household appliances, which are and shall be deemed to be, fixtures and a part of the realty and are a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned;
