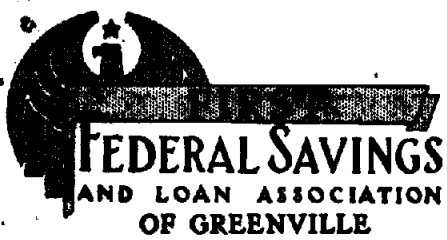

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

County of GREENVILLE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, A. J. Southerlin, Jr., of Greenville County SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said A. J. Southerlin, Jr.

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents and well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of: TWO THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 - - (\$2,500.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of TWENTY-FIVE AND NO/100 - - - - - (\$ 25.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said A. J. Southerlin, Jr.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to

the said A. J. Southerlin, Jr.

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within Greenville Township, on the Southeast side of Brandon Road (commonly referred to as Woodside Avenue), and being more or less the greater portion of Lot No. 36 of a subdivision known as Brandon Addition, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the P. O. O. of Greenville County in Plat Book A, at page 89, and being the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Brandon Road at the corner of Lot No. 35, which point is 149.88 feet South of the intersection of Morgan Street, and running thence along the line of that lot, N. 82 3/4 E. 173.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 7 1/2 E. 30 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 36; thence along the northerly line of said Lot No. 36, S. 82 3/4 W. 59.4 feet to an iron pin at the corner of a lot formerly belonging to J. L. Callender; thence along the northerly line of that lot, in a Northwesterly direction, 138 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the Southeast side of Brandon Road; thence along the Southeast side of Brandon Road, N. 15 1/2 E. 50.8 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, including all electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises.
