NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgage at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the surther sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Laurens, containing a fraction of an acre, in the City of Laurens, being more particularly lescribed by a plat of survey made by B. R. T. Todd, Laginger, June 14, 1949, as follows: Beginning at northeast corner on Moo lawn Street, thence N. 80 W., 75 feet to a point in Street; thence S. 16-30 W., 186 feet to a point; thence S. 71-15 E., 75 feet to a point; thence N. 16-45 E., 196 feet to beginning corner. Said lot is bounded on the North by Woodlawn Street; on the East by property of J. C. Cwings; on the South by hospital property; and on the West by property of C. Cwings; on Owings."
