in consideration of the said debt and sum of money
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

First National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina as Trustee
for W.S. Breazeale, Jr. all that tract or lot of land in
Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate,
lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, County and State aforesaid,
about nine miles North of the City of Greenville, S.C. and on the
Little Texas Road, adjoining lands of Mrs. Mary Hill, Mrs. Texie A.
Evins and others, containing Twenty and Sixty Nine One Hundredth
(20.69/100) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and
bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at a stone on the Little Texas Road, and
running thence N. 1/8 E. 11.00 to a stone 3XOM; thence N. 68.3/4
