All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the South side of Potomac Avenue, in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville, being snown as Lot No.239 on Plat of Pleasant Valley, Section 1, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1946, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book P, pages 92 and 93, and having according to said plat and a recent survey by R. W. Dalton, Surveyor, July 27, 1949, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
