Andrea all thet piece parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of Scuth Carolina, known as the same land conveyed to me by Irene Poole Johnson by her deed dated June 13, 1947, Decorded in Deed Book 313, page 316, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., being more particularly described as follows:
