All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land together with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville (formerly butler lownship) on the West side of By-pass Highway running between Laurens Road and Super Highway (known as S.C. Highway Vo. 201), in Greenville County, State of South Carolina and having according to a revised plat of property of E.C. King prepared by W. J. Riddle, Turveyer, November 2, 1947, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
