All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Cownship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the northwest side of Green Avenue in the city of Greenville and leing more narticularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the northwest side of Green Avenue 15.3 feet in a northwesterly direction from the northwest corner of the intersection of Green Avenue and Vardry Street, and running thence N. 14-53 W. 103.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 58-36 F. 74.5 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Green Avenue; thence with the most west side of Greenville Avenue S. 31-24 W. 71.3 feet to the beginning corner
