All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Northwest side of High Hill Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 54 on plat of Augusta Road Hills, made by Dalton & Hoves, Engineers, December 1940, recorded in the R. 1. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L, at pages 56 and 57, and having, according to said plat and a survey made by A. E. Dalton, June 21, 1963, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Migh Hill Street at joint front corner of Lots No. 54 and 55, said pin also being 130.2 feet in a Northeasterly direction from the point where the Lorthwest side of High Hill Street intersects with the Certheast side of Long Hill Street and running thence along the Lorthwest side of Aigh Hill Street, N. 42-10 E. 60 feet to an iron pin at joint from corner of Lots No. 53 and 54; thence with the line of Lot c. 53, N. 42-10 d. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot ho. 37, S. 42-10 d. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence with the certagest side of High Mill Street, the beginning corner.
