"BEGINNING at a stake on the South side of West Stone avenue, on the Northeast corner of the lot conveyed by Thomas B. Butler, as Trustee, to Julia McCarrell Foster by deed dated May 16, 1919 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 58 at page 14 (said stake being in the center of a 10-foot driveway created by said deed), and running thence Eastward along Stone avenue, 45 feet to an iron pin approximately 240 feet Westward from Wilton street (said stake marking the Northwest corner of Mrs. M. P. Costner lot); thence S. 4½ W. along the West side of the Costner lot and the rear of the C. L. H. Redmon lot (which fronts on Wilton street) 139 feet, more or less, to a stake which is exactly 81 feet from the Northeast corner of Parker street; thence approximately N. 87 W.
