Dollars, with interest at the rate of (16%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book N, at page 133 and also shown as Lot No. 65 on the plat of the property of J. F. Welborn, Sr., et al. as made by Dalton and Neves in August, 1949 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, at page 35, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Grove Road (also known as U. S. Highway No. 29) at the corner of Lot No. 64, which point is 350 feet Northeast of the intersection of Edgewood Drive, and running thence along the Northwest side of Grove road, N. 78 E. 51.5 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 66, according to the Welborn plat; thence along the line of Lot No. 66, N. 12-27 W. 190.2 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot on a 15-foot alley; thence along the line of said alley, S. 68-06 W. 50.8 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 64; thence along the line of that lot, S. 12-00 E. 181.4 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
