Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Northern side of Knollwood Lane in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot 166 of a subdivision known as Cleveland Forest according to a plat thereof prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in May, 1940, as revised in September, 1945, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 137, and a more recent plat entitled "Property of Clyde E. Stafford, Greenville, S. BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Knollwood Lane at the Southeastern corner of Lot 166, said pin being 160 feet Southwest from iron pin located on the Northwest corner of the junction of Knollwood Lane with Trails End; thence N. 22-25 W. 205 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots 166 and 195 on the West boundary of Lot 162; thence S. 65-02 W. 54.1 feet along the rear boundary line of Lot 195 to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots 166 and 167; thence S. 23-50 E. 201.9 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 166 and 167 on the North side of Knollwood Lane; thence N. 67-51 E. 60 feet along the North side of seid Lane to an iron pin at the Southeast corner of Lot 166, the point of beginning.
