NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, on the Southern side of East View Drive, near the City of Greenville, being shown as lot No. 30 on Plat of Clearview Heights, made by M. G. Woodward, December 1945, recorded in Plat Book P, at Page 1 and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Eastview Drive, 767 feet East from United States Highway No. 25, at corner of lot No. 31, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 18-04 E. 222.4 feet to a stake on Clearview Drive; thence with the Northern side of Clearview Drive, N. 75-33 E. 86.4 feet to a stake at corner of lot No. 29; thence with line of said lot, N. 18-04 W. 228.1 feet to a stake on Eastview Drive; thence with the Southern side of Eastview Drive, S. 71-56 W. 86.4 feet to the beginning corner."
