upon any public streets or highways or other lands, public or private; including, but not limited to, the following described transmission lines:

- (124) The 110 KV wood pole, single circuit, transmission line, 0.4 mile in length, serving the Town of Ramseur, North Carolina.
- (125) The 110 KV wood pole, single circuit, transmission line, 10.9 miles in length, serving the United States Reservation at Fort Bragg, North Carolina.
- (126) The 110 KV wood pole, single circuit, transmission line extending from the Company's Marion, South Carolina, 110 KV substation a distance of 39.6 miles to the Company's Lumberton Steam Electric Generating Plant.
- (127) The 110 KV wood pole, single circuit, transmission line extending from the Wateree Plant of Duke Power Company near Camden, South Carolina, a distance of 7.7 miles, to serve the plant of E. I. DuPont de Nemours Company.
- (128) The 66 KV wood pole, single circuit, transmission line, 1.5 miles in length, to serve the Burlington Mills at Neuse, North Carolina.
- (129) The 33 KV wood pole, single circuit, transmission line from Kingstree, South Carolina, to Hemingway, South Carolina, a distance of 23.0 miles.
- (130) The 22 KV wood pole, single circuit, transmission line from McColl, South Carolina, to Clio, South Carolina, a distance of 6.7 miles.
- (131) The 22 KV wood pole, single circuit, Wadesboro, North Carolina, tie line, 0.6 mile in length.
- (132) The 22 KV wood pole, single circuit, Chesterfield, South Carolina, tap line, 1.0 mile in length.
- (133) An additional 22 KV wood pole, single circuit, transmission line from the Lumberton Steam Electric Generating Plant to the Lumberton 110 KV substation, a distance of 2.9 miles.
