I, **Paul Montgomery** (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

with interest thereon from date at the rate of **six** per centum per annum, said principal ~~and interest~~ to be repaid: in **quarterly installments of \$100.00 each beginning April 1, 1950**, with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six (6%) per cent, per annum**, to be computed and paid quarterly

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of **Three (\$3.00) Dollars** to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in **Bates Township, containing one-third of an acre, more or less, adjoining property of W. T. Hudgens and C. M. Wing, and described as follows:**

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the G. & N. Railroad, and running thence S. 89-45 W. 1.37 chains to an iron pin on the Geer Highway; thence S. 23 E. 4.90 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 12 W. with the said Railroad to the beginning corner."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by W. T. Hodgens by deed dated December 1, 1947, recorded in Book of Deeds 329 at Page 17.
