WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcelor lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying and being on the Eastern side of Westview Avenue, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 8, 9 and 10 of Section B of Parkvale, a subdivision as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "K", Page 53, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Westview Avenue, joint front corner of Lot 8 and property belonging to Burgess, and running thence with Burgess's line, S. 89-30 E. 175 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 7 and 8; thence with the rear line of Lots 7, 6 and 5, S. 4-0 W. 225 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 4, 5, 10 and 11; thence S. 88-30 W. 175 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Westview Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 10 and 11; thence along Westview Avenue, N. 4-0 E. 225 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property is the same conveyed to us by Margaret P. Epting by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 397. Page 182.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
