bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as Executor of the Estate of  
W. M. Wheeler,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and  
being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina  
on the east side of Old Buncombe Road and having according to a recent  
survey made by W. J. Riddle, January 30, 1950, the following metes and  
bounds, courses and distances to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Old Buncombe Road, which  
iron pin is 209.4 feet south from the southeast corner of the inter-  
section of Old Buncombe Road and North Franklin Road, and running thence  
N. 88-38 E. 224.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 4-56 W. 17.1 feet to  
an iron pin; thence S. 88-39 E. 147.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 84-  
43 E. 16.8 feet to an iron pin in line of property of L. E. Gilliland;
