To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, George F. Hyde, Jr., of Greenville County, S. C., SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said George F. Hyde, Jr.,

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these

Presents, am well and truly indebted to H. W. Smith,

in the full and just sum of FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY and no/100 (\$550.00) DOLLARS,

to be paid AS follows: Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars on March 14th, 1950, and a like amount on the 14th day of each and every Succeeding Calendar month thereafter until paid in full; with the right to anticipate by the payment of all or any part thereof at any time before maturity,

with interest thereon from date

at the rate of Six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly,

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. W. Smith, his

heirs and assigns forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, west of and near the old Buncombe Road, on southeastern side of Long Forest Drive, being the western portion of that certain lot known and designated as Lot Number Thirty One (No. 31) on a plat of the Nabors and Bridges property, recorded in Plat Book "O" at page 195 in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and, according to said plat, in part, having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on southeastern side of Long Forest Drive, joint corner with Lot No. 30 of said plat, and running thence along southeastern side of Long Forest Drive, N. 40-33 E. 184 feet to point; thence continuing along southeastern side of Long Forest Drive, N. 64-06 E. 27.8 feet to point, joint corner with other property of the Smith; thence in a southeasterly direction, along line of other property of Smith, to a point in line of Lot No. 30, which point is One Hundred Thirty Three (133) feet easterly from the point of beginning; thence N. 89-35 W. 133 feet along the northern line of Lot No. 30, to the point of beginning.
