McDougale et al, by deed bearing date of April 8, 1941, and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County, S. C., in Vol. 231, at page 135. Reference is hereby made to the above-mentioned deed for a more complete description of this land; bounded by lands of Thompson, Taylor estate, Dr. Jones, J. L. Sims, and others.
