of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to mo, the said
war in the base of the constructed thereon

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of ..Greenville., and in Grova. Township, containing six acres as shown by survey made by B. R. Ledbetter, Surveyor, August 26, 1946, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Fork Shoals Road and running thence N.  $65\frac{1}{2}$  E. 16.58 to an iron pin; thence S. 23 3/4 E. 1.67 to a stone; thence S.  $2\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.40 to an iron pin; thence S. 75 W. 15.45 to an iron pin in the Fork Shoals Road; thence N.  $25\frac{1}{4}$  W. 2.50 to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same tract of land conveyed to me by E. E. Ashmore by his deed dated August 27, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 298, at page 89."
