All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, at the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Third Avenue and Goodrich Street, being shown as Lot No. 1, Section 1, on plat of Judson Mills No. 1, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated August, 1939, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book K, at Pages 11 and 12, and being described according to said plat and according to a more recent plat prepared by Madison H. Woodward, Registered Engineer, dated April 5, 1950, entitled "Property of Edward W. Burdette and Margaret T. Burdette", and having according to said plats the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Third Avenue, which iron pin is 95.0 feet in a Southwesterly direction from the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Goodrich Street and Third Avenue, said iron pin being situate at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, Section 1, Judson Mills No. 1, and running thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, S. 83-30 E. 128.4 feet to an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Goodrich Street; thence along the Southwestern side of Goodrich Street N. 49-02 W. 159.6 feet to an iron pin at the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Goodrich Street and Third Avenue; thence along the Eastern side of Third Avenue S. 4-30 W. 95 feet to the beginning corner.
