"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Summit Avenue, the joint corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 16, which pin is 357.2 feet west from the southwest corner of the intersection of Worth Street and Summit Avenue, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 34-0 W. 286.1 feet to an iron pin at rear joint corner of said lots; thence N. 58-30 W. 100 feet to the rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 14 and 15; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 34-0 E. 285.3 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Summit Avenue; thence with the South side of said avenue, S. 58-58 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
