of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars tomq, the said
in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon,
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,and .in .Greenvilla Township, School District 6-E, being a portion of Lot No. 128 of Flat No. 4 of "Camilla Park", which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 117, and being known and designated as Lot No. 3 of the property of W. R. Cordell, according to a plat thereof prepared by Dalton and Neves, May 5, 1950, and having, according to said later plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of the old Assley Bridge Road at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 3 and 4, which pin is 314.4 feet from the Eastern corner of the intersection of the old Easley Bridge Road with Cole Road, and running thence along the Southeast side of the old Easley Bridge Road, N. 54-23 E. 91.7 feet to an iron pin on the right-of-way of a Duke Power Company transmission line; thence along said right-of-way, S. 2-09 E. 293.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 89-34 W. 61.4 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 4; thence along the line of that lot, N. 5-33 E. 119.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the line of Lot No. 4, N. 16-27 W. 125.7 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
