(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Seven Hundred Ninety-Two and No/100

DOLLARS (\$792.00),

with interest thereon from ~~date~~ ^{maturity} at the rate of Six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$66.00 on June 17th, 1950, and a like payment of \$66.00 on the 17th day of each month thereafter until one year from date at which time the unpaid balance will become due and payable, with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of Six (6%) per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid monthly.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:
