proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

undivided three-tenths (3/10ths) and unto Thomas S. Bruce an undivided  
two-tenths (2/10ths) interest in and to all that tract or lot of land in  
Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.  
more particularly described as follows:

ALL That piece, parcel or lot of land, being the lands conveyed to  
Elvin J. O. Bishop, by Mitchell F. Mote and Nolie Mote of Greenville,  
S. C., having been conveyed to them by C. F. Haynesworth, Jr., as  
Trustee by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County  
in Volume 297, Page 355, dated August 19, 1946, and conveyed by said  
Mitchell F. Mote and Nolie Mote to Elvin J. O. Bishop by deed dated  
May 17, 1949, recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville
