Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina: in Gantt Township, being known and designated as how No. 235, Section A, of the property of Woodfields, Inc., a subdivision located on the southwest side of the Augusta Road, as shown on a plat of said property made by Piedmont Engineering Service on August 29. 1949, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, at page 75 and having, according to said plat, the Politowing metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Crestfield Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 234 and 235, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 234, S. 38-23 E. 119.5 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 233; thence along the line of Lot No. 233, S. 63-04 E. 56.9 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 232; thence No. 51-37 E. 35 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 233; thence along the line of Lot No. 236, N. 38-23 W. 160 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of Crestfield Road, joint Front corner of Lots Nos. 235 and 236; thence along the southeastern side of Crestfield Road, S. 51-37 W. 75 feet to an iron pin at the beginning corner.
