All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville, Greenville Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, being a part of lots Nos. 47, 48 and 49 on plat of Lanneau Drive Highlands made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August 1937, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book "D" at page 288 and 289 and having according to a more recent survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service dated July 22, 1950, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Lanneau Drive, which iron pin is 153.7 feet north from the northwest corner of the intersection of East Faris Road and Lanneau Drive, and running thence N. 80-59 W. 185.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 10-11 E. 90 feet to an iron pin the rear joint corner of lots Nos. 49 & 50; thence with the joint line of said lots S. 79-49 E. 159.9 feet to an iron pin on the west side of Lanneau Drive; thence with the west side of said Drive, S. 3-40 E. 52.7 feet to a point; thence continuing with the west side of said Lanneau Drive S. 9-43 E. 37.3 feet to the beginning corner.

Also one thirty-gallon automatic electric water heater.
