I, Mrs. R. V. Potts, of Greenville County, SEND GREETING:
WHEREAS, I the said. Mrs. R. V. Potts
in and byrnycertain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presentsamwell and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full
and just sum of TWO THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$2,700.00)
Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of
TWENTY-SE VEN AND NO/100 (\$27.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.
NOW KNOW ALL MEN, ThatI, the saidMrs. R. V. Potts
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in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms
of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars tome, the said
in band well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon,
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of .Greenville, and in Greenville Town ship, School District 8-AB, and being known and designated as the greater portion of Lot No. 15 of the property of Knox L. Haynsworth, Trustee, as shown on plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves in May, 1941 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book L, at page 177, and having the following metes and bounds,

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Summit Avenue at the corner of Lot No. 16, which point is 357.2 feet West from the Southwest corner of the intersection of Worth Street and Summit Avenue, and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 16, S. 34-0 W. 286.1 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence N. 58-30 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 14; thence along the line of Lot No. 14, N. 34-0 E. 135.3 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of a lot heretofore conveyed to F. W. Owens; thence along the line of that lot, S. 58-58 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 34-0 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Summit avenue, which point is 50 feet East of the corner of Lot No. 14; thence along the south side of Summit avenue, S. 58-58 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the greater portion of the lot conveyed to me by Horace Jack Joy by deed dated Feb. 20, 1950 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 403, at page 178.
