"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon,
Situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the west side of Whitney street in the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc. at Slater, being known and designated as Lot No. 7 of Block C as shown on a plat of the Village of S. Slater & Sons, nc., made by J. E. Sirrine & Co., Engineers, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at pages 64 and 65, and
aving, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Whitney street (formerly Hoover street) joint front corner of Lots No. 6 and 7 of Block C and running thence with the line of Lot No. 6, S. 87-32 W. 125.1 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots No. 31 and 32 of Block C; thence with the rear line of Lots No. 30 and 31, N. 2-28 W. 119.5 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots No. 7, 8, 29 and 30; thence with the line of Lot No. 8, S. 70-45 E. 145.15 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Whitney street; thence with the west side of Whitney street, S. 5-56 W. 66.4 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
