HDE CRIVING

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Berkley Avenue at a point 10 feet Northeast from the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 19 and 20, and running thence along the Northwest side of Berkley Avenue, N. 32-58 E. 71.6 feet to a point in the front line of Lot No. 21 at the corner of property belonging to John W. Arrington, Jr.; thence along a new line through Lot No. 21, 20 and 29, (this line being shown on a survey of Dalton and Neves, Engineers, dated August, 1950) N. 57-08 W. 271.2 feet, more or less, to a point on the Northwest side of a 10-foot alley shown on the above mentioned Riddle plat; thence along the Northwest side of said 10-foot alley, S. 46-41 W. 51.8 feet, more or less, to a point which is 10 feet Northeast of the rear corner of Lot No. 30; thence along the line of property heretofore conveyed by D.
