and just sum of Four Thousand, Four Hundred and No/100 (\$.4,400.00)
Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of
Forty-Four and No/100 (\$.44.00). Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and fore close this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expense of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of ...Greenville...Greenville. Township... on the North side of Orange Street, near the City of Greenville, being a portion of the lot conveyed to J. L. Love by Vessie Rainey Brandt, and also shown on plat recorded

in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book G, at page 248, and

having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Orange Street, corner of Lot No. I now owned by Charlie Shell, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 29 E. 108 feet to an iron pin in line of other property owned by J.
