SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said H. Frank Sargent  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these  
Presents, am well and truly indebted to Farmers Bank of Simpsonville

to be paid One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month with the  
first payment falling due one month after date hereof and a like payment  
due and payable each month thereafter until twelve months from this date

with interest thereon from date

at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly ~~in advance~~  
until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
