C. Wilson, containing ONE (1.00) acre, more or less, as shown by a survey made by W. F. Adkins, March 25, 1940, said land has the following metes and bounds to wit:

BEGINNING at a corner, joint corner of C. C. Wilson land and this lot, in the road, running thence with C. C. Wilson line, S. 41 1/2 W. 2.16 chains to a stake; thence continuing with C. C. Wilson line S. 36 E. 6.70 chains to a stake; thence S. 79 1/2 E. 56 links to a stone, T. D. Bennett corner; thence with Bennett line N. 22 3/4 W. 6.77 chains to road; thence N. 60 W. 75 links to the beginning corner.
