heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and
improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of
Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 226,
Pleasant Valley Subdivision, as per plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office
for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book P, page 114; said lot having
a frontage of 60 feet on the South side of Potomac Avenue, a depth of 160 feet on
the East, a depth of 160 feet on the West and 60 feet across the rear.
