Whereas, we, the said Ed Johnson and Alice Johnson

to be paid on January 7, 1952

with interest thereon from date
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually, in advance

C., located on the east side of the C. & W. C. R. R. in the Town of Mauldin, adjoining lands of Watson Green, Austin et al, and containing 2 acres more or less, according to a plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor in July 1948, and and being more fully described as follows:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the right of way of the C. & WC RR and joint corner with Watson Green and running thence along Green line N. 83-08 E. 625.5 ft. to iron pin on Austin line; thence along Austin line S. 0-25 E. 75 ft. to iron pin; thence still along Austin line S. 4-11 E. 287.2 ft. to iron pin on shaver line; thence along Shaver line S. 80-13 W. 23 ft to iron pin; thence N. 41-21 W. 365.8 ft. to stake; thence S. 76-44 W. 350.7 ft. to stake on C & WC Right of way; thence N. 17-38 W. 105.7 ft. to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to mortgagors by J.
