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and after any such designation the address designated shall be deemed to be the address of such party in lieu of the address hereinabove given.

SECTION 6. The invalidity of any one or more phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or provisions shall not affect the remaining portions of this Mortgage.

SECTION 7. This Mortgage may be simultaneously executed in any number of counterparts, and all said counterparts executed and delivered, each as an original, shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
