delivery of these presents and receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released,  
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Aluminum Products Company,  
Its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being  
in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina  
and being known and designated as Lot Number Three on plat of property  
of John Henry Smith as made September 26, 1949 by Pickell & Pickell,  
Engineers, and being described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Cagle Street as  
shown on said plat, at the corner common to Lots Number two and three,  
and running thence South 42-57 East along the line of Cagle Street  
Thirty-two and 5/10 feet to an iron pin; thence South 48-10 West One  
Hundred feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot Number One: thence along  
the dividing line between Lots Number One and Two, North 42-57 West  
Thirty-two and 5/10 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot Number Two:  
thence along the dividing line between Lots Number Two and Three, North  
48-10 East one Hundred feet to the place of beginning; said lot of land
