monthly until paid in full, all interest and cost when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if, before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder hereof necessary for the protection of his interest to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor's promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness of attorney's fees, thus to be added to the mortgage back-borders, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the ~~west~~, ~~south~~ side of Bradley Boulevard, shown as lot 163 on plat of University Park made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, November 1938, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book 8, at page 197, said lot fronting 75 feet along the northwest side of Bradley Boulevard, running back to a depth of 100.5 feet on the northeast side, to a depth of 125.5 feet on the southwest side and being 75 feet across the rear.
