"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the Southeast side of East Augusta Place Street, in the City of Greenville, and being shown and designated as lot No. 19, on plat of the property of E. C. Cass and D. W. Cochran, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at Page 261, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
